

Disclosure of Institutional Retention Rates 2022

UACCM is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's full-time and part-time retention rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Student Right to Know Act of 1990. The rates reflect the retention of a cohort of students who enrolled during the fall 2020 semester and who either completed a program of study or were still enrolled as of fall 2021. The **cohort** of an institution includes all first-time, degree or certificate-seeking undergraduate students that begin in the stated cohort year.

Full-Time Student Retention

During the fall semester of 2020, 388 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered the University of Arkansas Community College at Morrilton. As of the fall 2021 semester, 226 of these students had either completed a program of study or were still enrolled. Therefore, the full-time cohort retention rate was 58%.

Part-Time Student Retention

During the fall semester of 2020, 101 first-time, part-time, certificate or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered the University of Arkansas Community College at Morrilton. As of the fall 2021 semester, 48 of these students had either completed a program of study or were still enrolled. Therefore, the part-time cohort retention rate was 48%.
