STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

UACCM is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's full-time and part-time retention rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Student Right to Know Act of 1990. The rates reflect the retention of a cohort of students who enrolled during the fall 2021 semester and who either completed a program of study or were still enrolled as of fall 2022. The retention cohort includes all first-time, degree or certificate-seeking, undergraduate students that began in the stated semester.
