## TODAY

1. **Obtain free student photo I.D. and vehicle registration permit** at the Admissions Office in the University Center.

Note: Email and network account will be set up within a week of registration.

## COMING UP

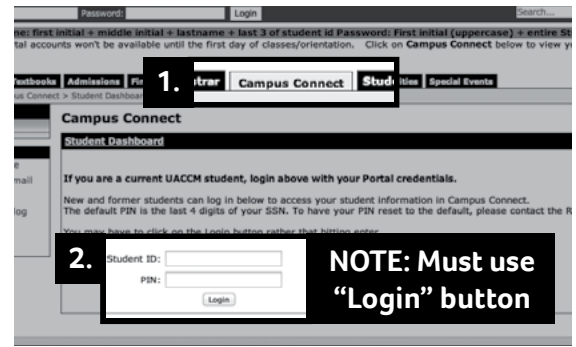
2. **Sign up and complete New Student Orientation.**  
*FFall On-Campus Orientations: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 3; FRIDAY, AUGUST 12; or MONDAY, AUGUST 22*

3. **Purchase books and supplies.**  
Check with University Bookstore for required book and supplies. Note: books and supplies for Career Center courses are provided for students. Book requirements may vary for students enrolled in a concurrent course taught at the high school.

4. **Pay tuition and fees online or at the Student Accounts window in the University Center or set up payment plan online.**

## ACADEMIC CALENDARS

### SUMMER 1 COURSES

- June 1 = Last day to drop with 100% refund
- June 3 = Last day to drop with 50% refund
- June 16 = Last day to drop 4-week courses with a “W”
- June 27 = 4-week courses final exams
- July 14 = Last day to drop 8-week courses with a “W”
- August 1 = 8-week courses final exams

### SUMMER 2 COURSES

- July 6 = Last day to drop with 100% refund
- July 8 = Last day to drop with 50% refund
- July 21 = Last day to drop with a “W”
- August 1 = Final exams

### FALL COURSES

- August 30 = Last day to drop with 100% refund
- September 7 = Last day to drop with 50% refund
- November 29 = Last day to drop with a “W”
- December 15-16 & December 19-20 = Final exams
