1. **Obtain free student photo I.D. and vehicle registration permit** at the Admissions Office in the University Center.

2. **Sign up for and complete Concurrent Student Orientation.**

3. **Check your personal email** for your UACCM computer account/login information and activate your account.

4. **Sign in to Workday Student** from the Microsoft Dashboard using your UACCM computer account/login to manage your process involved with admission, financial aid, academic advising, student records, and student accounts.

5. **Pay tuition and fees** at the Student Accounts window in the University Center or **pay in full/set up payment plan** online through Workday Student.
